

Together with you, we continue to go to the toughest places. This year Unto[®] served in 50 countries in every major region of the world.

Through the faithful partnership of people like you, we are going to the places where people consistently experience the effects of war, famine, drought, disaster, and poverty. Together with local Cru® missionaries, we seek to meet the humanitarian needs of those who are suffering — providing them with the food, clean water, and critical aid they so desperately need.

But that is just the beginning. By expressing the kindness of Jesus, people see that our local partners are not just there to drop aid and leave. Instead, our teams are indigenous to the areas where they serve. They build relationships and follow up with

those in need. They share about Jesus at appropriate times and in culturally sensitive ways.

This relational, long-term approach makes an eternal difference. Our teams in closed countries and other hard-to-access areas are seeing a great harvest. In places where there were just a few followers of Jesus a few years ago, now there are hundreds.

Our Southeast Asia team leader recently shared that they now have seven generations of new churches as followers of Jesus continue to multiply and tell others about eternal hope. Our partner in one extremely dangerous Middle Eastern country recently reported that 12 years ago, there were less than 150 known believers in the country; now there are thousands who follow Jesus and are connected to a home church!

We are hearing more and more stories like this as people continue to share hope with those who have never heard. I am reminded of Romans 15:20, "This has all been pioneer work, bringing the Message only into those places where Jesus was not yet known and worshiped" (MSG).

Together we are going to the toughest places — where it is difficult, dangerous, and even illegal to share the message of eternal hope. Through our humanitarian work, we are opening doors for Jesus to be shared so that everyone can hear the good news.

Thank you for partnering with us as we take help and hope to those in critical need. We celebrate all God has done through you over the past year. And we look forward to all He will continue to do in the coming year as we relieve suffering, restore dignity, and reveal hope in the toughest places.

MACHETES

In **South Sudan** it is not uncommon for children who have lost their parents to be forced onto the streets. Many times these children fall into gangs. Fighting between them is common.

One day Pastor John, a local Unto partner, stumbled upon two opposing gangs fighting each other with machetes. His heart broke at the sight, so he walked up to them and told them to stop.

"We'll kill you instead!" they threatened.

"Wait, just give me five minutes and listen," he boldly responded.

He began talking to the boys about Jesus. As he spoke, they laid down their weapons. When he finished, they asked him, "What do you have for us?"

Pastor John could not just leave the boys on the street. He fed them. Gave them a place to stay. And continued sharing about the hope of Jesus. That was only the beginning ...

Today more than 340 orphaned children, who once lived on the streets of South Sudan, are served through the orphanage that he founded.

Thanks to faithful partners like you, the children receive nourishing meals and other lifesaving aid. They also receive an education and vocational training while learning about God's love.

SUFFERING BUT NOT

FORGOTTEN

Luis* thought he could handle life on his own. But when he was bitten by a poisonous snake in the **Peruvian jungle**, everything changed.

He sought medical attention in his remote area, but his condition worsened. So he had to be transferred to the capital city for treatment, over eight hours away. Luis and his wife had no place to stay, and no family nearby to help. They could not afford the medical expenses.

For years, Luis' wife had prayed for her husband to follow Jesus.

When her local pastor heard about their situation, he contacted the Unto team serving in the city.

Soon the team arrived to help with meals, clothing, and shoes. They also helped with the family's medical expenses. As Luis experienced the kindness of Jesus, his heart softened.

Despite the doctors' attempts to save his leg, the poison continued to spread. Their only option was to amputate. Luis was devastated. He wondered how he would be of any use if he could no longer work to provide for his family.


In that moment, he realized he could not handle life on his own. Luis found peace in Jesus and trusted He had a plan for his life

RELIEF AND HOPE AFTER

THE STORM

For many in **Florida** and **North Carolina**, Hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton washed away everything they once knew. Entire communities were devastated by the storms.

Hurricane Helene hit the Carolinas with unprecedented fury. Beyond the storm damage, historic flooding washed away homes and left a trail of destruction.

Alvin's home survived, but falling trees crushed his cistern. He and his 93-year-old mother were left without water. They needed a new water tank, but they did not have a way to get it up the trail and to their home due to the fallen trees.

Unto disaster relief teams were able to cut a new path to Alvin's home and haul a new water tank up the mountain to Alvin's home. He was so grateful!

When the team asked if they could pray for him, Alvin readily agreed. He began to share about other challenges he was facing — including his son's drug addiction. His eyes filled with tears just talking about it.

So many families in the North Carolina mountains were already struggling. Now they need even more help — and hope. Unto disaster relief teams continue to serve people like Alvin.

As one volunteer shared, "I've never felt more like I'm doing exactly what I should be doing."



Dan and Stephanie McKeen wanted to make a difference. Jesus had radically changed their lives, and they wanted others to know about the hope they had found.

Stephanie is a medical doctor who was invited to join an Unto team on a mission trip to Central Asia. There she put her medical expertise to use and saw firsthand how humanitarian kindness opens doors for the message of Jesus to be shared.

Dan and Stephanie faithfully volunteered on Unto trips and gave to many ministries. But they wanted to do more. So they sat down with the team from Cru Foundation to discuss strategic ways to better leverage their assets for the kingdom.

After the meeting, Dan told Stephanie, "This is a whole new world for us. God has blessed us with the ability to make money, but we didn't know the most effective way to give. Yet Cru Foundation is all about stewardship and the Great Commission."

Dan and Stephanie set up a Great Commission Donor Advised Fund. They use their fund to give to a variety of Cru missionaries and ministries throughout the year, including Unto.

Stephanie shared, "God loves us so much that He welcomes us to partner with Him in the most critical work. He lets us go — and support people who go — all over the world. This is fun. This is the great adventure."
