A Fresh Start

Through our PowerPack[™] ministry, Cru[®] is supporting partner churches to make an immediate impact in the lives of local residents. However, the benefits of PowerPacks[™] go far beyond school supplies — they connect families to loving and supportive church communities and a deeper faith in Christ.

Adrienne grew up attending church and began a relationship with the Lord at a young age.

Unfortunately, many challenges in her life pushed her away from her faith, including an unhealthy relationship that left her caring for her two sons, Cooper (10) and Rylan (7), by herself.

Alone and out of options, she and her boys moved to Minnesota for a fresh start.

Upon arrival, she learned about a food shelf at New Creation Baptist Church, a partner church of Cru serving the inner city of Minneapolis. She made

note of the resource, but never visited. Then, last summer, years after hearing about the food shelf, she received an invitation to a back-to-school bash at the same church. In addition to fun activities, there would be PowerPacks filled with brand-new school supplies for her sons.

"I've heard of that church!" she remembered thinking.

Adrienne, Cooper, and Rylan attended the event and enjoyed food, a bouncy house, music, pantomimes, and a wonderful sense of community and belonging. It was so much fun! The boys got to pick out their own backpacks for the upcoming school year.

After being blessed with PowerPacks, Adrienne's family decided to visit the church for a weekly service. Moved by the Spirit, she re-committed her life to Christ that first Sunday and they became regular attendees. Soon after, Adrienne and her family decided they wanted to officially join the church. Her sons became involved in Sunday school. Now, both boys proclaim, "I want Christ to be the head of my life, the Lord of my life!"

With this new support, Adrienne has been able to secure a better-paying job and move into more suitable housing. At New Creation, Cooper receives direct mentorship from godly men in the church. And Adrienne's once-parched soul has been receiving spiritual nourishment through one-to-one discipleship by an older woman in the congregation.

By connecting people like Adrienne and her children to local churches through PowerPacks, Cru comes alongside communities of faith with lifechanging results.

In June 2019, Adrienne, Cooper, and Rylan were baptized at the summer church picnic, surrounded by their new church family. Thanks be to God!

From Jail to a Job

"When people find out this felony occurred in your past, what is their response?"

Larry thought before answering the question posed to him. "Most often, 'I never would've guessed that.' And that is the response I like to hear because I accepted that I had to be in that place [prison], but I didn't have to let that place be in me."

While in prison, God gave Larry a moment of clarity that began to turn him in a different direction. Larry explained, "For me, that moment of clarity came when someone was killed in prison. I

realized life has value. The life I live is crazy. I have to change. I didn't take it as a religious experience then, but God was telling me, 'I have something else for you.'''

Now Larry has his MBA and does small business consulting. Recently, Cru[®] connected Larry to a partner ministry, where he has started volunteering as a facilitator. Cru introduced Larry and this partner ministry to a tool called WorkNet and provided training on how to use this tool to help people overcome barriers to employment. In the end, twelve men completed the WorkNet curriculum, and now seven of the men are working and five are back in school.

"It gives guys the confidence to understand that they are employable. It helps them not just find a job where they dread going to work everyday but find a job that they really want to do and hopefully find their calling in life." Larry

> affirmed the impact this was having on the men. In fact, their transformation led him to help more inmates transition from prison to the outside world. He realized that

his own experience navigating a felony is an asset to helping others who are in similar situations now.

Hearing Larry share from his life, 2 Corinthians 5:17 comes to mind. "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." Praise to God for how He's transformed Larry's life and is now using him to minister to others coming out of hard situations.
