Sometimes, anxiety robs me of my joy. As we enter 2018, I'm pondering the Sermon on the Mount* as told in Matthew 6 and the impact it can have on us as we live by faith. Several verses have ministered to me:

6:25 "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about

your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing?"

We don't have to be anxious because life is more than the temporal things we often focus on. Instead, we can focus on the eternal!

6:26 "Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor gather into barns, and your Heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?"

We don't have to be anxious because life is Godgiven and He always gives exactly what is needed. The "struggles and suffering" in life bring us the joy of depending on Him! 6:32b "and Your Heavenly Father knows you need them all."

6:33 "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things will be added to you."

clutched a tattered cardboard sign that read "Need Help for My Family." Pastor Hugh said a quick prayer and felt the Holy Spirit nudging him to stop and talk to the man.


Praise God for how He works through the Homeless Care Kits to bring hope and encouragement to those who are in need physically and spiritually.

The Hidden Face of Homelessness

There are 553,742 people living on the streets, in cars, in shelters, or in transitional housing on any given night in America. Who are these people?

People experiencing homelessness often contradict stereotypes, as do the causes: a lost job, low wages, a large medical expense, family conflict, and mental health issues are among a variety of reasons. In 2017, a person working (full-time, year-round at minimum wage) could not afford the monthly Fair Market Rent for a two-bedroom rental unit in any state and still have enough money for food, utilities and other necessities.¹

What is clear throughout scripture is God's call to engage and care for those who have no place to rest their heads.









Each November, volunteers like Stacey and Joanne pack and deliver Boxes of Love® filled with a Thanksgiving meal and scripture to bring hope to people in need.

Just Like Acts

November is always an exciting month of outreach! Inner-city church partners and volunteers gather to pack thousands of boxes filled with stuffing, vegetables, potatoes, juice, yams, apple or cranberry sauce, bread, fruit, dessert, a turkey, ham, or chicken (depending on what is most culturally appropriate to the neighborhood) and more... plus scriptures.

The best part about Boxes of Love® is not just that a family in need gets to eat a fresh meal together in their own home, but that those who deliver the boxes are trained in evangelism. They're equipped to offer nourishment and hope that lasts longer than one meal.

In Chicago, a pair of volunteers—Stacey and Joanne—met a woman named Melinda on the street while distributing Boxes of Love and shared the good news of Jesus with her.

Melinda was so excited to hear about the free gift of grace and eagerly invited Jesus into her life.

She then turned to her 5 children in the car and exclaimed, "You need to hear this!" Upon hearing about God's free gift of salvation through Jesus, they all prayed to invite Christ into their lives.

Melinda couldn't contain her excitement: "I want

my mom to hear this too!" Her mom was in the house. So Stacey, Joanne, and Melinda went to the door and shared with her and she accepted Christ in her life as well! It was like the book of Acts when

whole families came to belief together!

We rejoice in God for orchestrating salvation for whole families through our church partnerships. Friends like you provide even more avenues for inner-city churches to minister to and connect with families in their neighborhoods, and many come to know Jesus.
