1. After reading about the international dinner story in the book, are you aware that there are people in the world who are spiritually starving? As you think about this story what emotions or thoughts do you have?
2. Have you ever, even just a little bit, considered going to another part of the world or people-group to share with them the Good News of the Gospel? Do you feel like this area of your life is open or closed to God? Why?
3. "Going means you don't stay" is a quote Hersh shares in this chapter. What are the things that are holding you back and making you stay?
4. What fears about the future hinder you from saying "yes" to the Lord? What do these fears reveal about how you are perceiving God? What are some Bible verses that can remind you of who God really is? ie. Ps 37:4
5. Reading Penn Jillette's quote on page 213-214, do you see any disconnects in your own life between your beliefs and your actions?
6. How does reading Paul's words in 2 Corinthians 2:1-5 encourage your heart in evangelism?
7. What faith steps is the Lord asking you to take as you considering the ideas of evangelism and going?
