





## A. ERASE THE THERE'S-NO-OPPORTUNITY MENTALITY

<sup>34</sup> Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work. <sup>35</sup> Do you not say, 'There are yet four months, then comes the harvest'? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest.



#### B. IT TAKES TEAMWORK

<sup>36</sup> Already the one who reaps is receiving wages and gathering fruit for eternal life, so that sower and reaper may rejoice together.<sup>37</sup> For here the saying holds true, 'One sows and another reaps.' <sup>38</sup> I sent you to reap that for which you did not labor. ### D. SUCCESS IN WITNESSING

Success in witnessing is simply taking the initiative to share Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit and leaving the results to God.
