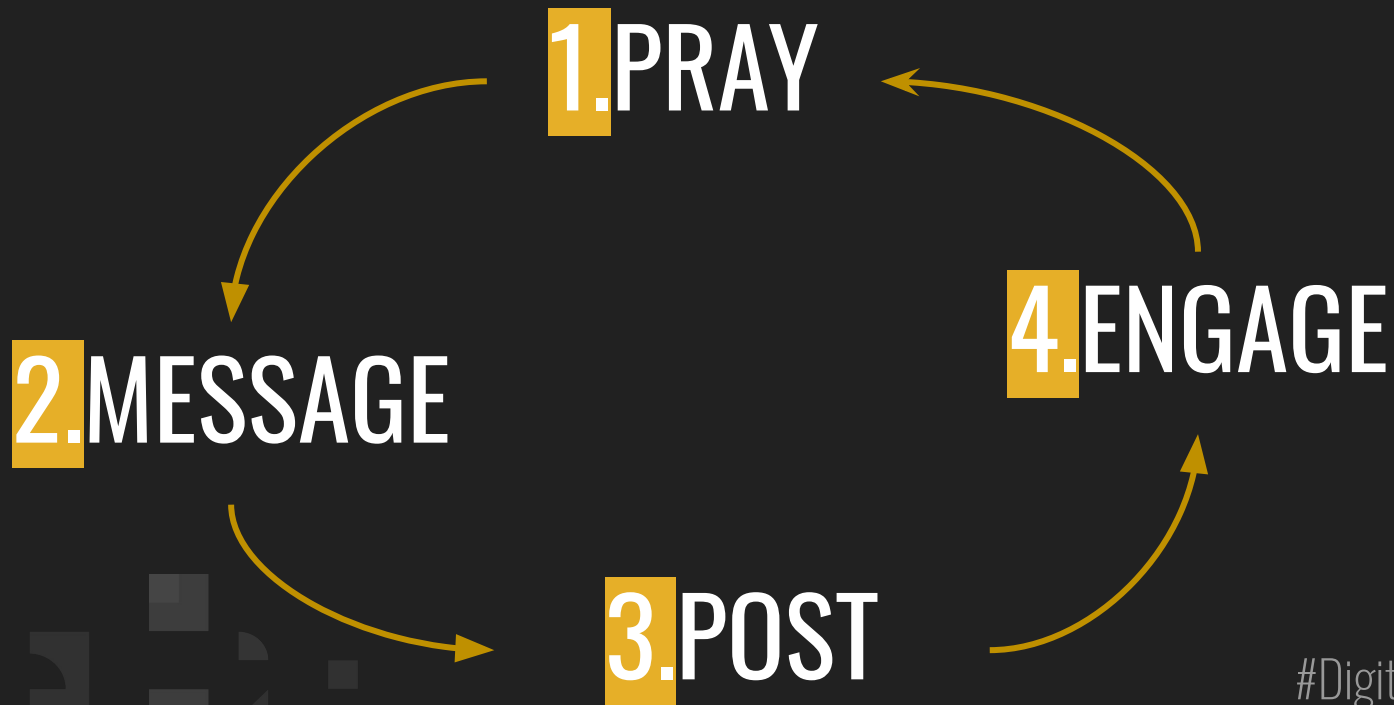

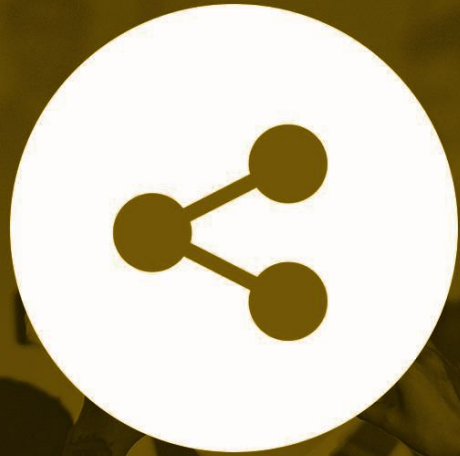

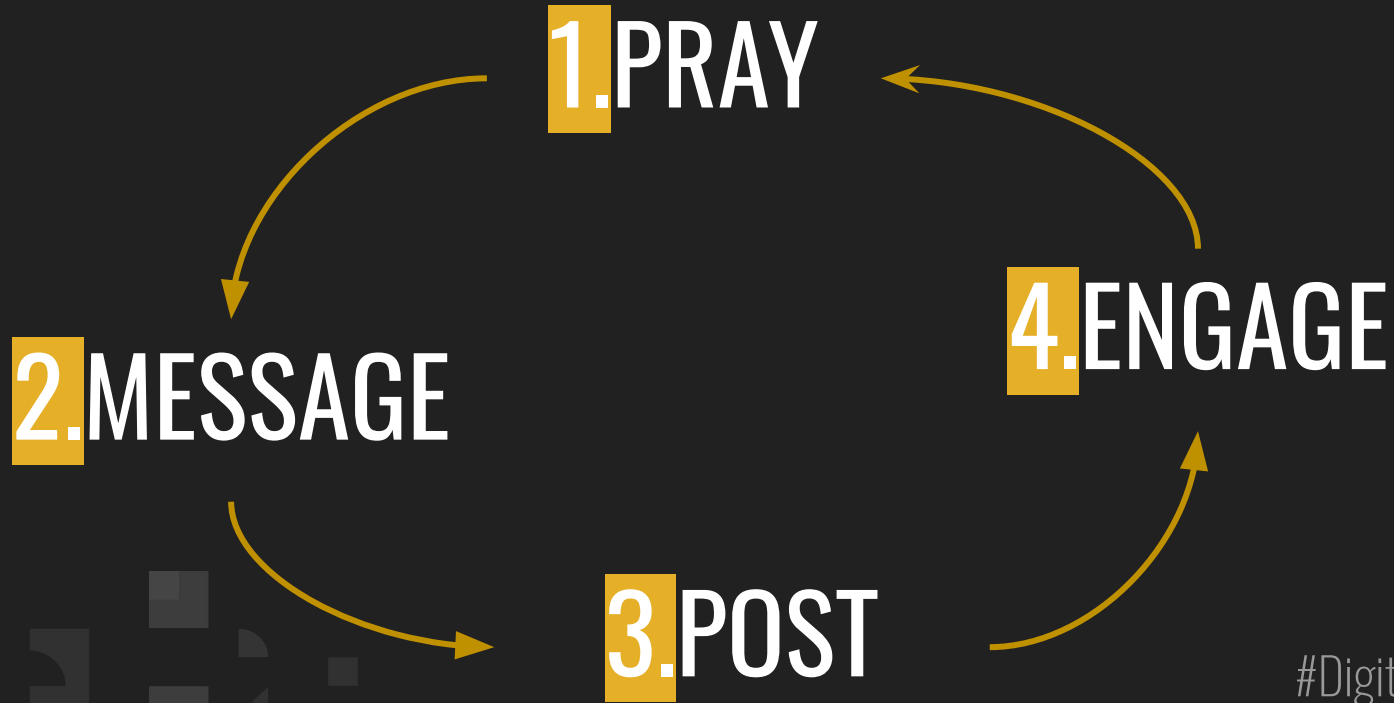

1. **‘Together-Alone’ time** Pray, Message, Post, Share
 2. **Small Group time** Share what God is doing, ideas, learning
Continue with ‘Pray, Message, Post, Share’
 3. **Final Large Group time** Share stories, what God did

PROGRAM FLOW

SAMPLE SCHEDULE

In this sample, the Digital Day of Outreach event is from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. It can be modified or extended to suit your context.

Step 1: Equip

3:00 p.m. - Welcome and Introduction to a Digital Day of Outreach

3:10 p.m. - Worship

3:20 p.m. - Devotion / Motivational talk

3:40 p.m. - DDO training (or review) and reminders (Adjusted according to the needs of the group.)

Step 2: Share

4:00 p.m. - Digital outreach starts

- Pray, Message, Post, Engage
['Together alone' time]
- Stories & Encouragement
[Interaction in small groups]
- Cycle repeats

Step 3: Celebrate

5:30 p.m. - Testimonies & Stories [Large Group time]

6:00 p.m. - End of event

UNREAL TIME PHENOMENON

when it takes 8 to 10 hours for your friend to reply

- ❖ Communicate your availability to discuss further
- ❖ Take time to respond when the friend is available
- ❖ Set a time for further conversation, communicating availability and intentionality

UNFINISHED CONVERSATION BLUES

PART 1

when your friend suddenly drops out of the conversation

- ❖ Just like in the Unreal Time Phenomenon situation, communicate sincerity in the conversation such as, “You can reply later on your free time”
- ❖ Be ready for the conversation to take off in another time and pray for your chatmate to also find the time to revisit the conversation

UNFINISHED CONVERSATION BLUES

PART 2

when your friend suddenly drops out of the conversation

- ❖ You can try to pick up the conversation at a later date mentioning “Hello, I realized we weren’t able to continue on the topic. I was wondering what were you thinking then..” or similar thoughts
- ❖ Be ready to answer the succeeding replies when your friend finally takes the time to reply back (Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction. 2 Tim 4:2)

SUDDEN THEOLOGY CONVERSATION

PART 1

when your friend brings the conversation into a sudden turn of doctrine and apologetics questions

- ❖ Ask the Lord for wisdom and opportunities to call or chat a friend so that you can answer questions together.
- ❖ Keep in mind that everyone is in a spiritual journey and that the Lord might be using the situation to let the other person think about these matters
- ❖ Thank your friend for the time he took to open up these questions to you

SUDDEN THEOLOGY CONVERSATION

PART 2

when your friend brings the conversation into a sudden turn of doctrine and apologetics questions

- ❖ If you don't know the answer, be honest and take the effort to research more on the topic. You can get back to your friend and take time to journey with them on this.
- ❖ As someone puts it, "Answer the questioner more than the question". Give a safe space for them to explore the topic together. Ask open-ended questions like, "How important is this answer to you?", "What made you think about these questions?"
